## Guys and Dolls Junior Audition Information:

The School Musical is a HUGE time commitment. Please do not audition if you are unwilling or unable to make the time commitment necessary. Regular cast members should plan on 3-4 nights per week (2 hours each & 3 hours Friday dance) and Leads can plan on 4-5 nights per week (2 hours each & 3 hours Friday dance). The final three weeks of the show will require everyone to be there 3-5 hours per night, show nights 5 hours a night. The rehearsal schedule is attached so you can make the necessary plans. Students who do not attend rehearsals may not participate in the show. Please list any possible conflicts on your audition form (vacations, appointments, lessons). It is imperative that you review the rehearsal schedule prior to auditioning and make sure your schedule will work well with the musical's timetable.

There is an activity fee of \$40.00 to participate. This will be due at the first rehearsal. Additional costs may be incurred (makeup, personal costume pieces like tights, shoes, etc.) This is similar to being on a sports team and paying the activity fee, then buying cleats.

The audition is a two day process for all students, three days if a student is called back to read for a specific roll. Students should bring their signed permission slip and volunteer form to their first audition. There **is kissing** in this show. Characters Sarah Brown and Sky Masterson will kiss. Nathan will kiss Adelaide on the cheek. If you are unwilling or unable to kiss another character, DO NOT audition for these roles. There are plenty of roles that do not kiss in this show.

Day 1 (Required Singing/Acting Audition): Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday August 21<sup>st</sup> (by sign up time).

Singing/Acting: Sign up for your audition time on Mrs. Hayward's door (room 1617). Download the mp3s (from Mrs. Hayward's website <a href="www.starbase47.com/mrshayward">www.starbase47.com/mrshayward</a>) and learn one of the required songs. Song choices are: I'll Know (girls), Bushel and a Peck (girls), Luck be a Lady (boys) and Sit Down You're Rockin the Boat (boys). Students should come prepared to sing the song clip with the background accompaniment. Please come with the song you have selected memorized. After singing, students will do a quick "cold read" on one of the roles from the show.

Day 2 (Required Dance Audition, Thursday, August 22nd on the stage 3-5:30pm) Everyone who wants to be in the show must come to the dance auditions on Thursday. This will be held on the stage. Please wear shoes that you can dance in. Do NOT dance in flip flops! This audition will begin at 3:00 pm and students will learn a dance and then pass it off in groups for the choreographer and director. If you have extensive dance or tumbling experience, please come prepared to show (tumbling passes, back handsprings, toe-touches, ballet leaps and tour jete, pirouettes, fuettes, etc.). Plan on staying until your pass off is complete (anywhere from 5-5:30 pm, depending on how fast students learn the dance).

Day 3 (Callbacks - for those students on the above list - Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup> 3-8pm in the choir room) A callback audition is when a student is "called back" to sing/act/dance for a specific role.

If you are on the callback list, please come Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> at 3pm to the choir room. Not all students will be called back to read for specific roles, but may be cast in the show. Some students may be assigned smaller roles without being called back. These callbacks will go as late as 8:00 pm for leading roles - other roles will be released when they have been heard. Please send a snack to the school for your student if they are called back and wish them well!
