Before signing this permission slip, please read the following:

The musical is a HUGE time commitment! Students who are selected through the audition process to be part of the show will be expected to attend **ALL** of their scheduled rehearsals. Students will not be excused from rehearsals for other activities.

Communication is essential!! If a student is ill, please e-mail Mrs. Hayward to let her know as soon as possible. ***Please, please, please schedule orthodontist, dentist, etc. on open rehearsal dates. There are several days that students do not have rehearsal each month, please re-schedule existing appointments to those days, if possible. We have had problems in the past with students reporting zero conflicts on their audition form, only to announce vacations, appointments, other activities after they have been cast. Please check the entire schedule and have your student be honest on their form. I have cast leads that had a family vacation planned, but knowing in advance made it easier to work with them and prepare ahead of time.

The school musical is one event that does not require a minimum GPA. If you are concerned about your personal student's ability to maintain grades and do this musical as well, please don't have them audition. A great many students are able to handle the show and grades, but this is a personal decision to be made with you and your student PRIOR to auditioning.

There is kissing in this production. Sarah and Sky are kissing roles. Nathan will kiss Adelaide on the cheek. If you are NOT okay with this, please do not have your student audition for these roles. There are plenty of other characters who do not kiss in this production.

This is a wonderful opportunity! The memories your student will make doing Guys and Dolls Jr. will last a lifetime. The friendships they will form through the course of this show are priceless. I have been in many shows and the bonds I have made were the best memories of my school years. Thank you for your careful consideration, and we wish your student the best of luck in auditions!!
